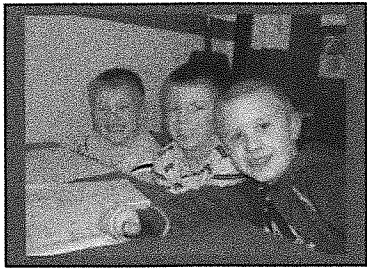


Educating Children for Over 55 Years

Price Schedule

Childcare w/ Preschool:
5 days a week - \$120⁰⁰/week
1-4 days a week - \$25⁰⁰/day

Preschool/Pre-Kindergarten Only:
5 days a week - \$70⁰⁰/week
1-4 days a week - \$15⁰⁰/day

There is \$50⁰⁰ non-refundable registration fee for all new students & a \$50⁰⁰ annual enrollment fee for each following year.

Our Curriculum

Spiritual

Our students are taught that Jesus is their best friend who loves, cares, forgives and is with them. This is taught and experienced through prayer, worship, singing and learning God's Word.

Intellectual

Our program promotes language development, listening skills and oral expression; identifying and recognizing numbers, letters, shapes, colors.

Physical

The children in our program learn to care for their personal needs, develop their large and fine motor skills and eye-hand coordination, by engaging in activities such as cutting, coloring, skipping, running and balancing.

Aesthetic

Our students engage in self-expression through art, music, rhythm, and imaginative play.

Emotional

Our students will know that they are secure and loved by God, staff, and students. Growth in positive self-awareness and accepting responsibility for their behavior is encouraged.

Social

Our program works to help children strengthen their relationship with God and with others. It encourages cooperative play, sharing, showing concern for others, and resolving disagreements in positive ways.
